This term, we will be looking at Forces and Magnets in Science. We have already investigated how far a toy car travels on different surfaces, as well as looking at pushes and pulls at the park!

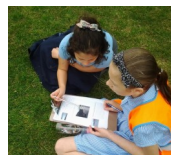


Year 4

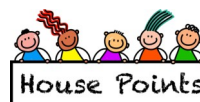
