## Harvest

Thank you for all your kind donations of food for our Harvest Festival today. Our visitor's from the Food Bank charity were overwhelmed with the amount and variety of food that was collected. Well done to all the classes for their wonderful songs, poems and performances in our Harvest celebrations today. It was lovely to see parents and carers attending the assemblies to help us celebrate.

## Parking

Please could I remind parents and carers who bring their children to school by car that we have an arrangement with Sainsbury's (Western Approach) whereby you can park in their car park for FREE at key drop off and pick up times (08:35 to 9.15 and 14:55 to 15:35). Recently, we have had requests from the police and the parking department to reduce the congestion and parking on double yellow lines around school. Parking on the double yellow lines puts the safety of children walking to school at risk. I appreciate that parking on the roads is a problem in this area but I would ask that parents and carers who travel to school by car use the Sainsbury's car park. All you need to do is to fill in an application form with your vehicle details and we can issue you with a permit from the school office. I am sending an application form home to you with this Newsletter in the hope that more people will use this option. It would be great if we could soon see a reduction in the number of cars parked on double yellow lines outside school.

## Attendance Awards

As you know, we like to celebrate and reward good attendance at school. Each week, in assembly, we celebrate the class who have the best attendance and at the end of the year we present 100% attendance medals to children who have come to school every day for the year. This year, I would like to introduce an **additional award to encourage good attendance**. Any child who has had 100% attendance for a half term will have a 'Golden Ticket' entered into an end of year prize draw. This will give each child the possibility of having **up to 6 tickets** in the draw by the end of the year. We will then draw 3 tickets with prizes of £50 book tokens being awarded to each winner. With all these awards on offer, I am sure that we will be able to achieve our attendance target of 96.3% this year!
